Artist Agreement: Exhibiting artists and the Castle Rock Artist Cooperative (CRAC) form an alliance when an artist submits work for consideration for exhibits. That alliance creates responsibility for both parties. CRAC does a considerable amount of marketing and promotion for exhibits and the contributing artists. Artists, however, need to be present and completely involved in the process. They should send out invitations of their own, share relevant social media posts, submit a portfolio of work with artist/bio statements and business cards, and attend opening receptions and be prepared to talk about their work. The artist should help with hosting, staging, planning, and/or marketing of the event.

Please initial each item as requested to acknowledge an understanding of the terms of this agreement.

1. I am a CRAC member in good standing
2. I understand that 2-D artwork must be framed or appropriately finished and ready to hang from a wire with D-rings placed no lower than 2" from the top of the frame.
3. I understand that a label is to be provided that clearly identifies the artist's name, phone number, website, and email; artwork title, medium, and suggested price.
4. I understand that 3-D art must be ready for display with a label with the same information as 2-D art. Any specialty display items, such as display tables, must be provided by the artist.
5. I understand that CRAC does not facilitate the sale of displayed artwork. Buyers must contact the artist directly to arrange for payment and delivery of artwork.
6. I understand that I am expected to keep all artwork displayed for the agreed display period, regardless of sales.
